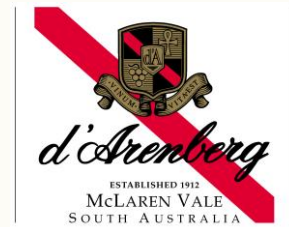




2012 d'ARENBERG THE BLIND TIGER

93 pts “Opaque purple. Exotically perfumed aromas of raspberry, boysenberry, cassis, rose oil and incense, with notes of licorice and spicecake emerging with air. Fleshy, appealingly sweet dark berry liqueur flavors coat the palate, with floral pastille and star anise notes providing complexity. Rich but also lithe and balanced, finishing with excellent clarity and persistent floral and spice character. These vines were planted in the mid-1920s.”
