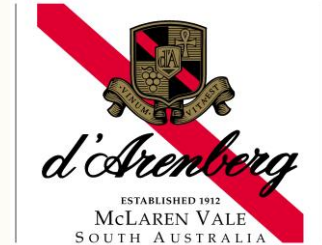

Fleshy and expansive on the palate, offering energetic blackberry and cherry-cola flavors that put on weight with aeration. This rich yet lively shiraz finishes with excellent cut, supple tannins and lingering sweetness. According to Chester Osborn these vines were 102 years old this vintage.”
