94 pts “Dark purple. Intense, spice-accented aromas of cassis, violet, olive paste and smoky minerals; smells a lot like a high-end, ripe-year northern Rhone wine. Spicy dark berry and floral pastille flavors show superb focus and depth, along with a smoky flourish on the back half. The extremely long floral finish features slow-building tannins and lingering sweetness. These vines were reportedly planted in 1916.”
