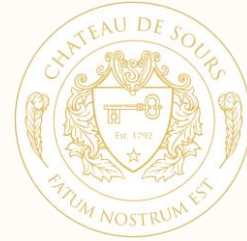




2014 CHATEAU DE SOURS BORDEAUX ROSÉ
