89 pts “Attractive, warm lightweight nose of cherry fruit with overtones of soft oak, licorice and lavender. There’s an almost “hot marshmallow” sensation that may sound strange, but is actually very pleasant. Flavors are ripe and loose-knit, with light cherry elements persisting and refreshing acids that keep it vibrant yet ultimately smooth. Winemaker and owner Alberto Antonini’s approach here is a fine success.”
