90 pts “Deep ruby. Lively, spice-tinged aromas of cherry, redcurrant and fresh flowers, with a subtle hint of herbacity in the background. Broad and appealingly sweet on the palate, offering pliant red and dark berry flavors that tighten up on the back half. The floral quality comes back strong on a sweet, persistent finish framed by supple, late-arriving tannins. This wine is quite approachable now, especially with a little air time.”
