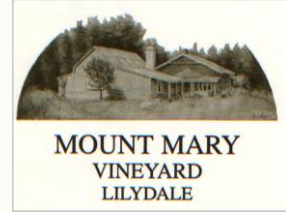




2011 MOUNT MARY QUINTET
