92 pts “Concludes its fermentation and 20 months maturation in French oak (50% new). Lively cassis and redcurrant fruits lead the medium-bodied palate, continuing in an unbroken stream through to the finish and aftertaste; oak trembles on the brink, but retreats at the last moment.”
