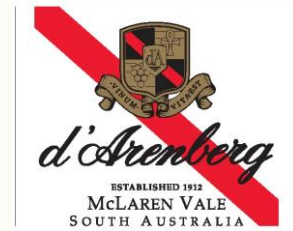




## 2013 d'ARENBERG THE TWENTYEIGHT ROAD

**91 pts** “Brilliant ruby. Powerful, spice-accented dark berries, cherry and candied licorice on the highly perfumed nose. Juicy blackcurrant, bitter cherry and violet pastille flavors are lifted and sharpened by zesty acidity and a strong jolt of peppery spices. Lingers with very good intensity on a subtly sweet finish given shape and grip by fine-grained tannins.”
