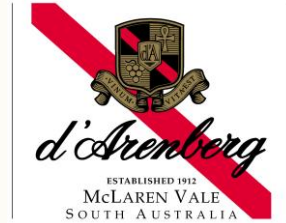




2014 d'ARENBERG THE STUMP JUMP WHITE
