88 pts – Very Good “This dark brick red colored blend from Oveja Negra opens with a pleasing blackberry bouquet which includes hints of cedar, mint and light plum. The palate is light bodied, slightly dry and displays black cherries, light tannins and a touch of spice. This combination of Malbec and Petit Verdot provides the wine with good balance and structure. The wine finishes with a smooth and extended dry finish. I would pair this Chilean good value red with a shepherd’s pie.”
