**90 pts – YEAR’S BEST AUSTRALIAN SHIRAZ** “Emily Laughton makes this wine from an organically farmed vineyard planted in the granitic soils (rather than Jasper Hill’s Cambrian soils) south of Heathcote. The flavors are variations on umami, from black mushrooms to briny olives and notes of leather. The tannins add hints of bitter chocolate and warm edges of crushed stone. It’s a substantial body (15.5 percent alcohol) but carries itself well.”
