94 pts “Fermented with submerged cap header boards 8-9 days, finished fermentation and matured in new French and American oak for 21 months. There really is a forest of oak in the wine, even though the barrel fermentation helps integration. May well escape from the forest in the years ahead, for the quality of the fruit is not in doubt.”

Deep and alluringly sweet but also focused, offering powerful black and blue fruit and violet pastille flavors and a jolt of peppery spices. Smoothly plays richness off of elegance and finishes very sweet and long, with building smokiness. smooth tannins sneak in late to add shape and closing grip.”
