

## 2010 d'ARENBERG THE CENOSILICAPHOBIC CAT

### Review Summary



**92 pts** “The wine is a blend of Sagrantino and Cinsault which are two relatively new plantings to McLaren Vale. The nose shows attractive notes of American oak that works well with deep set red fruits. The palate has a light, juicy red fruited aspect with elegance and structure backed by fine, grippy tannins and mineral acidity. I really like the style of this wine, it’s got an easy drinking style that benefits from quality oak inputs but is light enough on its feet to really spark interest.”

**92 pts** “A blend of sagrantino (85%) and cinsault (15%) that delivers cassis and redder fruit aromas along with cedary notes, some wild herbs – straightforward wine showing a little bottle development at 6 years of age. The palate has a spark of acidity that drives a shiny, glossy texture, liquorice and black fruit flavors, quite ripe; tannins hold the finish nicely.”
