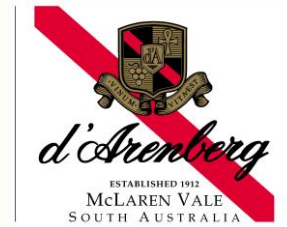




2011 d'ARENBERG THE BONSAI VINE
