It offers plenty of dark, berried, inky fruit; plenty of sawdusty/smoky oak; and while it’s warm with alcohol it remains smooth, supple and persistent. In other words, it ticks the boxes most red wine drinkers are looking to have ticked. Indeed it’s excellent value. It’s all blackcurrants, bay leaves and aforementioned oak. Tannin is fine-grained. It’s one of the more positive reds I’ve seen come out of Penley Estate in some time.”
