



## 2012 KILIKANNOON ATTUNGA 1865 SHIRAZ

### Review Summary



**94 pts** “Inky purple. Drop-dead, intensely perfumed aromas of ripe blueberry, cassis, incense and vanilla, with woodsmoke and violet nuances emerging with aeration. Smoky, concentrated and penetrating on the palate, offering vivacious black and blue fruit flavors that stretch out and become more lively on the back half. Finishes extremely long and sappy, with outstanding focus and smooth, even tannins that build slowly and fold effortlessly into the wine's plush fruit. As the name suggests, these vines date back to 1865.”
