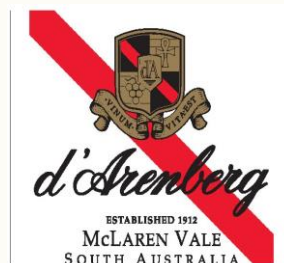




2013 d'ARENBERG THE DERELICT VINEYARD

Full-bodied with a solid structure of velvety tannins and plenty of freshness, it fills the mouth with berry coulis and cracked pepper flavors, finishing long.”
