93 pts “Sweet red berried fruit, yes, but much more than that. This is a wine with the ability to pick its moments. It’s elegant for the most part, start and finish, but when it’s time to go, it pours on the boysenberried, earthen, spice-shot spearmint flavors, ushering fine-grained, smoky tannin along with them.”

In a seamless, fruit-driven style, with excellent closing focus and supple tannins building steadily and adding shape.”
