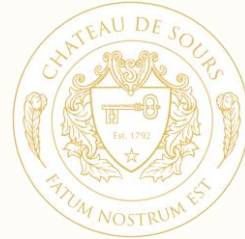




2016 CHATEAU DE SOURS BORDEAUX ROSÉ
