REGION: Margaret River, Western Australia

VARIETALS: Merlot (63%), Malbec (25%), Petit Verdot (12%) MATURATION: 11 months in French oak barriques (11% new)

ALCOHOL: 12.5% alc/vol

VINTAGE NOTES:

This wine was made from a carefully selected blend of Merlot, Malbec and Petit Verdot grown on the Mangan Vineyard, which has been shown to be ideally suited to nurturing these grape varieties. The growing season for the 2013 Mangan was favorable with good spring rains and a warm ripening period. Low yields due to hail and storms at flowering produced very concentrated berries.

WINEMAKING NOTES:

The fruit was carefully sorted before fermentation with indigenous yeasts and malolactic bacteria. No acid or yeast was added, producing a wine which has a sense of place through the grapes and natural winemaking techniques employed.

TASTING NOTES:

Lively aromas of fresh plum, rose petals and violets are backed by a touch of vanillin oak. The very attractive blend of rich plum, cherry, spice and black pepper flavors have produced a marvelously opulent middle palate that is backed by lovely soft tannins. A delicious and pure fruit - driven wine.
