Shows very good flavor intensity but comes off lithe, finishing with firm, nervy cut and a touch of candied rose.”

The flavor profile is a mineral infused light tangerine with hints of lime and strawberry. The finish is dry and refreshing. This pleasant Rose would pair nicely with grilled shrimp.”
