95 pts “Very much McLaren Vale in personality, although of course the vineyard applies its own stamp as well. The first impression is of baked earth, with the term ‘ironstone’ coming to mind, although that may be geologically flawed. Beyond that the wine shows notes of anise, caraway and lavender sprinkled through the ripe red fruit, the palate buoyant and long in flavor.”
