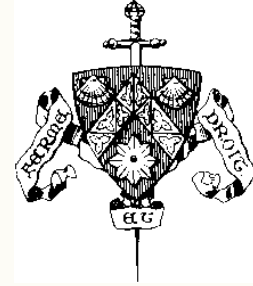


## 2014 YERINGBERG SHIRAZ
