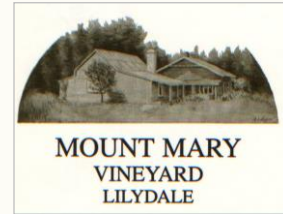




2013 MOUNT MARY CHARDONNAY

97 pts “Has the power and intensity that positively ancient vines (in Yarra Valley terms) and a sacred site makes almost inevitable, the vintage also chipping in. The special quality of Yarra Valley chardonnay is length, on display here in all its glory, the fruit flavors precisely aligned between citrus and stone fruit, the oak ex barrel fermentation and maturation now part of the fabric of the wine.”

Shows excellent power and depth on the impressively long finish, which echoes the peach and floral notes.”
