94 pts – TOP WINES “Focused and expressive, with an overlay of about a dozen different kinds of pepper adding interest and depth to the cherry and floral flavors, focusing into a compact beam as the finish lingers amid lightly prickly tannins.”

93 pts “Opaque ruby. Highly fragrant blackberry, boysenberry and Indian spice scents show excellent clarity and pick up a vanilla quality with aeration. Impressively concentrated but lithe, offering sappy red and blue fruit and floral pastille flavors that caress the palate and show no rough edges. Candied lavender and spicecake notes cling on a very long, gently tannic finish that echoes the blue fruit note.”
