Review Summary



90 pts “Bright ruby. Ripe cherry and blueberry on the perfumed nose, accompanied by a hint of mocha in the background. Smooth and seamless in texture, offering pliant blue fruit and floral pastille flavors, while a hint of white pepper adds back-end spiciness. Finishes supple and broad, showing good persistence, a hint of sweet tobacco and no obvious tannins.”

90 pts – Very Good+ “This pitch black colored Cabernet Sauvignon from down under opens with a blackberry and thyme bouquet with a hint of eucalyptus. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, balanced and savory. The flavor profile is a dark chocolate influenced blackberry with notes of minerality. I also detected hints of black currant and a touch of oak. The finish is dry and its moderate tannins show nice staying power. This Cab is a very good value. I would pair it with pan roasted duck with cherries and red wine vinegar.”
