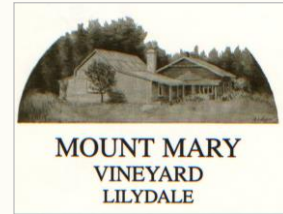




2014 MOUNT MARY CHARDONNAY
