92 pts “Vivid yellow-gold. An expansive bouquet evokes ripe melon, nectarine and candied orange and carries an intense floral overtone. Juicy, plush and subtly spicy on the palate, offering sappy citrus and pit fruit flavors enlivened by a gingery nuance. Shows very good depth and subtle creaminess but comes off lively, even nervy. The impressively long, silky finish leaves notes of tangerine and candied ginger behind.”
