95–97+ pts “A barrel sample blended of 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Cabernet Franc and 1% Petit Verdot, the 2016 Proprietary Red Three Graces displays a very deep purple-black color and nose of fresh blackcurrants, black cherries and black plums plus suggestions of pencil shavings, bouquet garni, violets and tilled soil with a waft of cloves. Medium to full-bodied, the palate possesses great elegance, with a fine yet firm frame of very ripe, soft tannins and plenty of freshness to lift the youthful fruit layers, finishing with great length and depth.”
