91 pts/Editors' Choice “Unlike the rich, powerful Shirazes of South Australia, Western Australia’s cooler climes produce wines more reminiscent of the Northern Rhône. Leeuwin’s version swirls and twirls with notes of tangy orange rind, bright cherry, meat, cola and cumin spice. Light to medium bodied, it’s silky and elegant but with some power too. Juicy fruit and savory tannins complete the package.”

89 pts – Very Good “This ruby colored Shiraz from Leeuwin is a very good value. It opens with a black cherry bouquet with hints of anise and cigar box. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, balanced and juicy. The flavor profile is a red plum and oak blend with notes of red raspberry. We also detected hints of anise mixed in as well. The finish is dry and its fine tannins fade away nicely. We also noted a touch heat present, but it was not distracting. This Syrah is food friendly and the Panel suggested pairing it with coq au vin or lamb stew.”
