The cherry and floral notes cling nicely on a long, incisive finish framed by fine-grained, nicely integrated tannins.”

The flavor profile is a tasty blueberry and plum blend with hints of cinnamon and faint oak. The finish is dry and flavors fades away nicely. This Pinot is very food friendly and would pair nicely with coq au vin.”
