89 pts “Brilliant red. High-pitched strawberry and candied rose scents are complemented by suggestions of musky rhubarb, white pepper and succulent herbs. Shows good energy and lift to the juicy red berry and floral pastille flavors, and a hint of orange zest adds a firming edge. Closes taut, spicy and precise, fine-grained tannins adding shape and grip.”
