90 pts “The 2014 vintage was one of the first that highly regarded winemaker Kate Goodman helped into bottle, and her lighter touch is just starting to become apparent on this wine. It’s a rather flashy, heady style, bursting with aromas of ripe, almost raisiny cherries and red currents, black pepper, Chinese five spice and dusting polish. The palate is soft and satiny in texture with a savory spine and a toasty oak finish.”

Juicy dark berry, mocha and spiced flavors show good depth and no rough edges. Finishes bright, sweet and long, featuring a repeating vanilla note and round, even tannins that come in late.”

89 pts “The 2014 Hyland Coonawarra Shiraz sports a deep garnet-purple color and has scents of incense, cloves, allspice and Sichuan pepper over plum preserves, cedar and Marmite toast. The wood is standing out a tad on the medium to full-bodied palate, with a good core of spicy fruit and rounded tannins, finishing with lingering cedar notes. It should be a cracker if that oak integrates as I expect in 2-3 years.”
