92 pts “Aged across a combination of new and used French (80%) and American oak, this mid-weighted wine boasts blue and black fruits, a skein of peppery acidity, deli smoked meats and sinewy, mid-range tannins, far less bracing than those exhibited by the Cabernets of the range. This wine plays the herbal card well, without straying into excess or hardness.”
