96 pts “It has a fragrant savory/spicy bouquet, characters that come through strongly on the palate. The tannins per se are not a force, the savory bitter chocolate notes coming from the fruit. One of Robert Parker’s 70 best winemakers in the world.”

94 pts “As always, the 2015 Emily’s Paddock contains just a dash of Cab Franc, but it’s enough to give the wine a slightly leafy, lifted quality to the nose and a sense of freshness on the palate. At 15% alcohol, it’s a full-bodied, rich wine, but it also comes across as elegant, with those hints of green herbs helping to frame ripe cassis flavors. At this youthful age, there’s some cedar and vanilla still evident, but those will integrate with time to deliver more of a cigar-box impression. Fine-grained tannins impart a tea-like feel that lingers on the finish.”
