92 pts “Most red drinkers will thoroughly enjoy this. It offers plenty of dark, berried, inky fruit; plenty of sawdusty/smoky oak; and while it’s warm with alcohol it remains smooth, supple and persistent. In other words, it ticks the boxes most red wine drinkers are looking to have ticked. Indeed it’s excellent value. It’s all blackcurrants, bay leaves and aforementioned oak. Tannin is fine-grained. It’s one of the more positive reds I’ve seen come out of Penley Estate in some time.”

89 pts – Very Good “This opaque and dark ruby colored Cabernet Sauvignon from Australia opens with a spearmint and black currant bouquet. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, slight acidic and juicy. The flavor profile is a red currant and plum blend with notes of with hints of mild pomegranate and thyme. The finish dry and its flavors drift away nicely. This Cab is very food friendly and would pair well with grilled Italian sweet sausage sandwich.”
