94 pts “Pencil shavings, herbal-floral notes and plenty of bright fruit spark the nose of the 2016 Emily’s Paddock Shiraz Cabernet Franc. Full-bodied and richly textured, it’s a creamy, supple, tannic cocktail of blueberry, plum and raspberry fruit layered over deep, earthy notes of tapenade and espresso. Despite its hefty alcohol (labeled at 15.5%), there’s no discernible heat, just a big, sexy beast that deserves some time in the cellar.”
