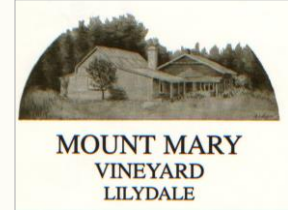




2010 MOUNT MARY PINOT NOIR
