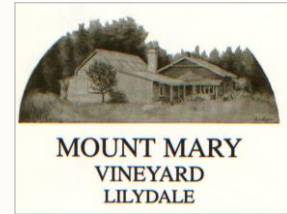




2013 MOUNT MARY QUINTET

Review Summary



96 pts “Bright, clear color; the fruit-filled, fragrant bouquet is followed by a classic Mount Mary palate: medium-bodied, and with a certain transparency akin to an orchestra with different instruments, the very essence thereof; near the flute are red fruits, the violin the black fruits, the bassoon tannins – all very different, but all in harmony, the sum of the parts greater than the whole.”

94 pts/100 BEST WINES OF THE YEAR “This wine’s elegant structure lends it the kind of sophistication that’s rare in Bordeaux blends from outside their home region. Five Bordelais varieties make up this blend: cabernet sauvignon (49 percent), merlot (26 percent), cabernet franc (15 percent), petit verdot and malbec. It shows delicate red fruit and cedar scents, with complexity in the grape-skin tannins, which yield spice and a fine form of richness. One of the most collectible reds in Australia, this is built to develop for years in the cellar.”

94 pts “Vivid ruby. Potent black currant, cherry and cedary oak aromas are complicated by notes of cured tobacco, candied rose and cracked pepper. Silky and seamless on the palate, offering fresh dark berry, bitter cherry and mocha flavors plus a touch of smokiness. Delivers a serious punch of flavor and comes off lithe and precise. Finishes with supple tannins, a jolt of peppery spices and outstanding, floral-driven persistence.”

92+ pts “Blended of 49% Cabernet Sauvignon, 26% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc, 6% Petit Verdot and 4% Malbec, the 2013 Quintet displays a medium garnet color and nose of ripe red currants, blackberries, dried herbs and black raspberries with hints of pencil shavings, black pepper, cloves and dusty earth. Light to medium-bodied, fine, fresh and with tons of energy, the palate is laden with red berries and herbal flavors, framed by chewy tannins and finishing with great freshness.”
