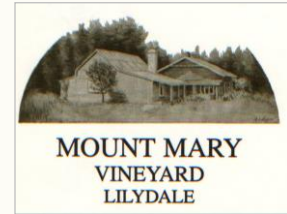




## 2014 MOUNT MARY QUINTET
