96 pts “The wine has presence, charm and elegance in equal measure. A blend of cabernet sauvignon 66%, cabernet franc 13% with splashes of merlot, petit verdot and malbec, all of which has created a medium-bodied wine. Expect a mix of red berries and leafy freshness, some menthol and spice with super fine tannins and excellent length. It’s a contemplative wine to savor.”
