Review Summary



95 pts “Like all Kilikanoon’s Rieslings, no frills to the vinification, just attention to detail. Incongruously, it is a blend of three vineyards. The bouquet owes as much to minerally notes as to citrus fruit, and the palate duly brings structure and length for the lemon/lime flavors and firm finish.”

93 pts “A year from now, this wine will likely overtake the 2015, once it sheds its youthful fermentation aromas and builds on the powerful lime explosion that stands in for its fruit. Put on your pith helmet if you open this now; shake it for a few minutes in a decanter and you might get to the clean, fresh, bright and juicy side of the wine. Cellar it for another seven to eight years and the citrus fruit will begin to mass around the mineral acidity, becoming a compellingly rich, complex white.”
