VINTAGE:

2017 was a textbook cool climate vintage. The preceding winter was cool to cold with good rainfall and ground saturation as the valley moved into spring. The growing season was characterized by intermittent rainfall with otherwise cool to mild days, bright sunshine and importantly, no temperature peaks. As a result, all varieties enjoyed slower ripening where acids, sugar and flavor stayed well in-sync. The resulting wines have terrific structure and detail, underpinned by crisp natural acidity and bright fruit.

WINEMAKING:

The fruit was 100% hand-picked from Giant Steps' Sexton, Applejack, Gruyere Farm, Wombat Creek and Tarraford vineyards. Indigenous fermentation took place in 500L French oak puncheons at 60 - 74°F. The total time in oak was 7 months with the lees stirred for the first two months only. 30% of the puncheons underwent malolactic fermentation. The wine was not filtered prior to being bottled by gravity.

TASTING NOTES:

The nose offers aromas of lemon pith, white peach and crushed hazelnuts with mineral undertones. The palate is long, elegant and broad with a beautiful creaminess from the extended aging on its lees. A backbone of crisp and punchy acidity carries flavors of stone fruits, citrus and shortbread through a persistent finish.
