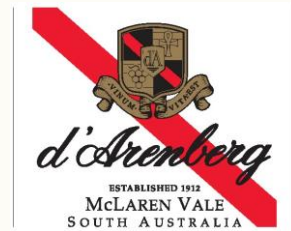




## 2015 d'ARENBERG THE COPPERMINE ROAD

### Review Summary



**95 pts** “What a boon the ‘15 vintage was. My mind snapped to attention as I tasted this wine. It’s so perfectly pitched, all the components from the bouquet to the aftertaste lining up on the parade ground, split-second timing a la Chinese marchers. Cassis is permeated with fine-grained tannins and framed by oak, McLaren Vale chocolate absent – with leave.”
