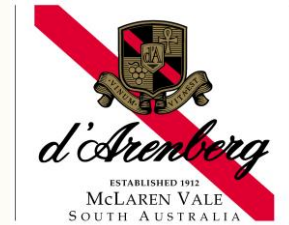




2015 d'ARENBERG THE CUSTODIAN GRENACHE
