91 pts “This gets a fair bit of love for the entry cuvee, with 30% of the blend barrel fermented in second and third pass barrels coopered in Bordeaux. The result is a seam of tangy citrus and tropical fruit notes, with an undercarriage of garden herb, lemon grass and tonic. What’s not to like?”

90 pts – Very Good+ “This almost clear colored Sauvignon Blanc based wine from Leeuwin is very good! It opens with a fragrant gooseberry bouquet with a hint of nectarine pit. The flavor profile is similar to the nose. It features gooseberry, yellow grapefruit, lime and stone fruit pits. I also detected hints of white pepper, saline and chalk minerality. The finish is dry and its flavors and integrated acidity show nice length. This Sauvignon Blanc would pair very nicely with swordfish skewers.”
