

2016 GREG NORMAN ESTATES SANTA BARBARA PINOT NOIR



REGION: Santa Barbara County, California
VARIETALS: Pinot Noir
MATURATION: Seasoned French oak and stainless steel
ANALYSIS: 13.5% alc/vol | 5.2 g/L TA | 3.62 pH

REGION: Santa Barbara County enjoys a long growing season, perfect for the development of concentrated and balanced fruit. The coastal climate is key - it is just warm enough that the fruit fully ripens, yet not too hot that vegetal undertones appear. The well-draining sandstone and limestone soils consistently produce small berries that are richly concentrated. The majority of the fruit for this wine was sourced from hillside vineyards in the cooler end of the North Canyon.

WINEMAKING: After a gentle destemming process, the whole berries were fermented in stainless-steel, open-top tanks and punched down daily. A portion of the wine gained complexity with time in French oak. The remainder of the blend was aged in stainless steel to preserve the fresh fruit flavors and maintain a good acid structure to the finished wine.

TASTING NOTES: This food-friendly Santa Barbara Pinot Noir hosts vivid aromas of farm fresh strawberry, red cherry and rosewater. The inviting nose leads to a juicy palate with bright flavors of red raspberry, strawberry, black tea and an intriguing note of soy. The palate is highlighted by sweet vanilla notes and is well-balanced with a lively acidity that is a hallmark of the Santa Barbara area.
