92 pts “Minty and floral on the nose, the 2014 The Galvo Garage Cabernet Sauvignon-Petit Verdot-Merlot also boasts scents of cassis and black olive. It’s full-bodied and concentrated, with a firm but expansive mouthfeel and a rich, velvety feel on the finish.”

91 pts “This Bordeaux-style blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Merlot shows plenty of d’Arenberg character while also walking to its own beat. It needs a bit of swirling in glass or decanter to come together but when it does it reveals notes of soy sauce, stalks, raspberries and roasted beets on both the nose and the palate. The mouthfeel is granular, smudged by spicy tannins and a lick of toasty oak—a powerful but charming wine.”
