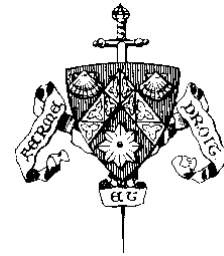


## 2016 YERINGBERG SHIRAZ
